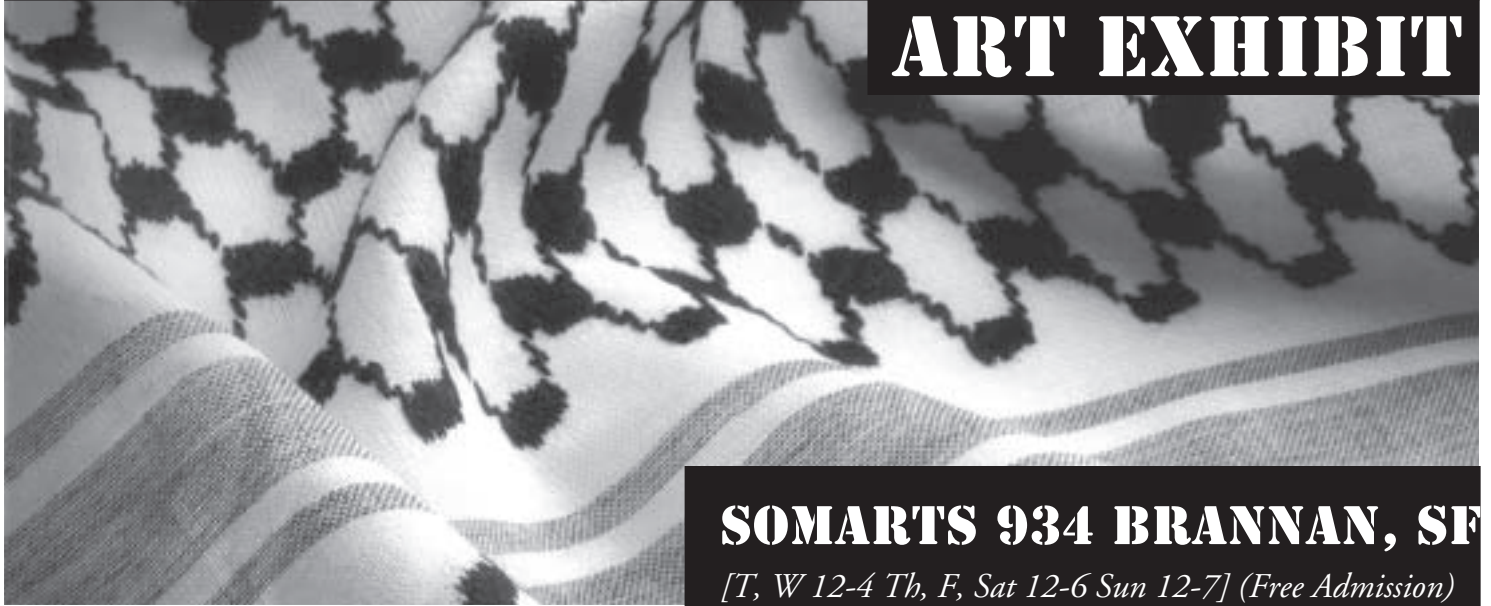

Made In Palestine on view at SomArts, San Francisco, April 7 through April 21, 2005. The exhibition showcases a collection of contemporary art made by 23 Palestinian artists and refugees, who live in the occupied territories and the Diaspora. The works on display cover a wide range of media and present individual reflections on the Palestinian contemporary experience and the political situation in Palestine. The Station Museum, Houston, where the show originated, described *Made In Palestine* as "the first exhibit of contemporary Palestinian art ever displayed in the United States."
